



believe information in science<sup>8</sup> researches<sup>9</sup>, Business<sup>10</sup>, and so on<sup>11</sup> is contributed<sup>12</sup>  
to improve society<sup>13</sup> around the world<sup>14</sup>. That is, people can easily<sup>15</sup> seek out

Despite the advantages above, in my view<sup>17</sup> ,<sup>19</sup> some valuable information should  
not be posted on the Internet. Firstly, it will cause excessive use of information.  
The easier<sup>20</sup> public can get it, the lower the level of information is, even though  
the content is treasure<sup>21</sup>. Secondly, over-copy is a considerable problem<sup>22</sup>, which  
violate intellectual property of authors<sup>23</sup>. Sometimes, people steal concepts or
